**TREASURER:** This newsletter will arrive with your winter tax bills that are due by February 14<sup>th, 2023</sup> We send tax bills to everyone even if you have them paid by your mortgage company. Look on the upper left corner of the tax stub at the bottom third of the tax bill where it says "Mortgage Co." if there is a company printed there they are asking for the tax bill to process payment. We send the tax bill to you so you know how much your taxes are that the mortgage company is paying.

Payments received after February 14, 2023 will have a 1% interest per month and a 3% penalty added. To get correct amount owed, please call Township Treasurer's office.

After February 28th taxes have to be paid at Kalamazoo County Treasurer's office. Mail payments to:
